 - Civic Space
 - Finishing up construction the first week of May
 - The month of May they will be adding furniture/equipment/supplies and hiring staff
 - Grand opening with June 18
- Other
 - Disc Golf Course at Autrey Park
 - Still need to install baskets but signs are up
 - Soft opening and doing a community event

We talked about our pool walk and got an update on pool renovations as well as reviewed potential survey ideas for the pools.
