- Alex (Mohawk Cir) raised concerns/questions regarding spraying and what is being sprayed on community areas, Notes referenced questions around community awareness and communication. General concern noted around future Town ownership, management, and control considerations related to parks/open space areas

 - Mentioned median and irrigation work at Rock Creek Parkway & McCaslin, Approximately \$280K noted, PARC expressed support/endorsement for SWEP grant effort

4. New Business and Updates

- a. Updates from Town staff and/or Town Council Liaison – got updates on pool timeline for opening, closing and construction. SCC construction to begin in August, lasting 2-3 months. Block party trailer reservations opened and doing well, reserved for 8 weekends.
- b. Summary points of meeting: The committee discussed priorities around smaller park maintenance, programming opportunities, and future community engagement efforts, with a strong focus on Pirate Park and expanding summer programming. Conversation also touched on long-term considerations for park ownership/management, upcoming events, and support for the SWEP grant tied to the Rock Creek Parkway/McCaslin area.
